Activity ideas:

- *Walk- can you see any squirrels on your daily walk. (observe social distancing rules) What are they doing? How do they move/behave? Create a series of actions mimicking how squirrels move/behave. Describe them using adjectives and adverbs.
- *Speech bubbles - Write speech bubbles for the characters.
- *Write a review of the book - What is it about? Did you like it? What did or didn't you like most? Who would you recommend the book to and why do you think they will like it?
- *List the rhyming words in the book. Can you start your own rhyming word dictionary?
- *Can you make an advert for the book and record it?
- *Write a diary entry for the 2 main characters about the same event.
- *Make a comic strip for Cyril and Bruce - with a new adventure! (pictures with captions!)
- *Choose one of the illustrations in the book and describe the setting. Use adjectives (describe) and conjunctions (joining words) to extend sentences. How did the author describe the setting?
- *Music - draw 4 images linking to the story - eg squirrel, tree, cone, bird. Make body percussion of vocal sounds to go with each picture. Cut them out and mix them up. Make the correct sound to match each picture as you turn them over. Put the sounds together in different orders. Which order did you like best?
- *Maths - Cyril needs pine nuts for winter. If he needs 2/5/10 nuts a day, how many will he need for 3 days/ one week/ 10 days?
- *Science - find out about squirrel habitats or food chains.
- *Art /DT - Make/draw paint a squirrel - can you make a moving picture? Create a woodland habitat for your squirrel?
