

Maths home learning 15.06.20 'Number 17, 18, 19, 20'

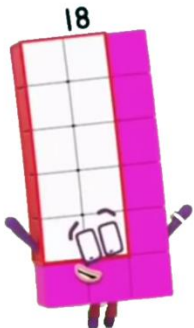
This week we have decided to look at the final 4 numbers altogether.

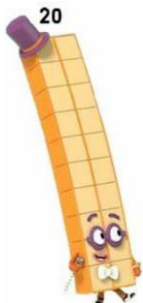
-find number 17 on the number line, - find 1 more, 1 less.

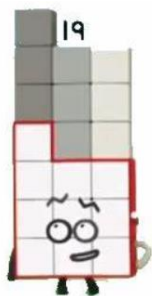
-find number 18 on the number line, -find 1 more, 1 less
